ALLISON

Dextroamphetamine? Does Trevor have ADHD?

Mrs. Wynn frowns through her tears.

MRS. WYNN

No. Why?

ALLISON

That's what the drug's usually prescribed for.

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10 CONTINUED:

DEVIN

But if you don't have the condition, the body can be overstimulated and react badly.

MRS. WYNN

There's been a mistake. Trevor has a heart murmur, so he would never take anything like that. He can't even have caffeine.

ALLISON

Mr. and Mrs. Wynn, I mean no disrespect, but I have teenagers, too. This reaction to the drug generally indicates long-term use.

MR. WYNN

(getting angry)

If he took that, someone made him. Trevor is a good boy. A smart boy. He knows better.

MRS. WYNN

And he doesn't keep secrets.

Allison and Devin exchange a quick look.

MR. WYNN

Please. You must find out what really happened to our son.

ALLISON

We promise you, we will.
