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INT. WARD - ISOLATION ROOM -- DAY

Zach sits by Vivian's bed.

VIVIAN

What happened?

ZACH

You had a seizure, Viv. Probably
caused by the high fever.

She looks towards through the glass of the door.

VIVIAN

Is that...?

ZACH

Sam. Yes. He's been out there for
hours.

VIVIAN

Feel like I'm in a police line-up.

Sam knocks on the window, holds out a finger, he wants to
show her something.

He scrambles to get something out of his knapsack--

VIVIAN (CONT'D)

What's he doing?

ZACH

No idea.

(CONTINUED)

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CONTINUED:

They watch at the window as Sam holds up a set of CUE CARDS.
He holds them up in the window.

Hi. My Name is Sam. (He drops one) And I have done many.
(He drops another) MANY. MANY. (He drops another one) Stupid
things in my life. (He drops one) Loving you. (Another
drop) Is NOT one of them.

Vivian turns to Zach, tears in her eyes.

VIVIAN

Am I ever going to get out of here?

ZACH

I don't know.

A knock at the door. Maggie enters, blood results in tow.

ZACH (CONT'D)

Think we're about to find out.

MAGGIE

Your blood work is back.

VIVIAN

(Maggie grins wide)

Dr. Lin. You're not wearing your
protective suit.

(realizing)

Oh God... Oh my God...

She grabs Zach, hugs him for dear life. He looks at Maggie.

MAGGIE

Giardia.

ZACH

It was the pygmy hippos. Never
thought I'd say that.

VIVIAN

What?

MAGGIE

Giardia's a parasite. A nasty one.
That's carried by the feces of
infected animals.

ZACH

The symptoms mirror Ebola.

VIVIAN

But, I'm not going to die?

(CONTINUED)

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ZACH

You will, yes. Most definitely.
But not from this.

MAGGIE

Healthy dose of antibiotics, more
fluids, you're going to be fine.

VIVIAN

Thank you. Thank you.

MAGGIE

Thank Dr. Miller, he was the one who
rushed in while you were seizing.

(beat)

Turns out, he's a bit of a cowboy.

Zach shoots Maggie a look.

END

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INT. I.C.U. - NURSES' STATION -- DAY

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Alex approaches. Patrick fills out paperwork.

PATRICK

You'll be happy to know our patient
Naomi is stable.

ALEX

Good news. I'm not surprised though--
A "surgeon of your caliber"...

(to the DESK NURSE)

I got a page about my patient, Mr.
Crenshaw.

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The nurse hands Alex a chart, on the fly, leads her into
Crenshaw's room. Patrick follows:

NURSE

We've tried everything Dr. Reid.
But, he's not waking up from surgery.

ALEX

What?

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INT. I.C.U. - CRENSHAW'S ROOM -- CONTINUOUS

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Alex approaches Crenshaw's body. She rubs a balled fist
against his chest. Nothing.

ALEX

(to Patrick)
Pinch his feet for me?

(CONTINUED)
