

KING OF COMEDY 1 - 1 (B)

SHE

Rupert... Rupert, I've gotta talk to you for a second. What happened last night? Is Jerry okay? Did he talk about me?

HE

No, he didn't talk about you. We talked about me, as a matter of fact.

SHE

HE

He didn't say anything about you. What's he gonna say about you after what you did in the car last night? Personally, I think you were a supreme schmuck last night.

SHE

Hold on a minute. I'm the schmuck? Me? You're wrong, buddy. You're very wrong. If I hadn't got in that car last night you'd never have even gotten the chance to talk to Jerry. Keep that in mind, okay?

HE

Listen, I don't want to be cruel, but we're in front of Jerry's building. God forbid he should see me with you, because Jerry and I have a real relationship going, you know what I mean? KING OF COMEDY 1 - 2

SHE

SHE

Just do this for me Rupert. What about the times I did things for you?

HE

What have you done for me? You haven't done anything for me. What are you talking about?

SHE

HE

I think maybe you've got your mind screwed up, 'cause you never bought me anything. I bought my own coffee.

SHE

You never bought anything. You bought nothing.

HE

What about the things I did for you that no money can buy? No money can buy! What about when I gave you my spot? You came over here and I gave you my spot. I let you stand right next to Jerry. I waited eight hours for him and you went right next to him. What about the time I gave you my last album of "The Best of Jerry", what about that? It wasn't anyone else, it was me.
