MIKE

Oh, wait... You didn't mean to do what? Get wasted? Drive? Or you didn't mean to cripple my son?

**AGATHA** 

The doctor's right, Mike. We shouldn't --

MIKE

My boy... wakes up in the morning, he runs. He runs all day. He runs to the track to practice running.

Jennifer's turning an even whiter shade of sickly pale.



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MIKE

So when he wakes up this morning, if he wakes up, what am I supposed to tell him? That you're so sorry he can't run? Maybe never again?

**JENNIFER** 

If I could take it back--

MIKE

Well, you can't. Colin had a future. Had hope. Now what do we have?

Jennifer staggers forward, remorseful and still a little drunk. Her mascara's not holding up.

**JENNIFER** 

I'm so sorry.

MIKE

Back away before I do something I really want to do.

Officer Hendricks, Donna, and Dr Erickson shoulder in between the two.

DR ERICKSON

This won't help anybody. Colin needs you guys right now.

**AGATHA**

Mike steps to the trophy mantle--


#### MIKE
