Look what Marc brought back from London....

Millie please, listen....

She

He

Millie...

She

You should have seen him, he was so embarrassed, he kept trying to turn it on the side so I wouldn't notice, do you think that's quite right, he came here to hurt me and he brought me a box of biscuits?

He

What he told you, it isn't true.

She

I told him that myself and sent him on his way in the rain.

He
